6. The short listed participants will then be competing for the Mr. ROTASIA NEPAL 2012 and Miss ROTASIA NEPAL 2012 titile during ROTASIA NEPAL 2012.

Round 1: shortlisting of participants on the basis of information provided and full size photograph

Round 2(Introduction) : pariticipants will be judged on the basis of personality looks, custom and makeover(of their choice), mass appeal , charisma while they take a ramp walk presenting themselves – 15marks

Round 3(Dabali): 2 minute will be given to each participant to show their talent and they will be judged on the basis of their talent, presentation, custom, confidence, mass appeal and time management - 25 marks

Round 4(Rotaract): Answering the questionnaire on the basis of Rotaract Knowledge (History, Protocols and standard rotaract club constitution, by laws and statement of policy) - 20 marks

Open only for shortlisted 10 boys and 10 girls

Round 5 (About Nepal) 3 rapidfire gestions related UNESCO Listed World Heritage Sites of Nepal – 20 marks

Open only for shortlisted 3 boys and 3 girls

Round 6 Spontaneity, confidence level and substance of speech will be judged while the participants answers the judges question – 20 marks
